

SCRAPPY APPLIQUE WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST

Scrappy Applique Pattern (required)

Printed patterns will be available for **purchase** at the workshop. Digital patterns may be purchased and printed before the workshop. **See patterns at katielewisquilting.com**

Scrap fabric for the collaged appliqué piece

Equivalent to 8-12 fat eighths is perfect. You can use scraps from your scrap bin. I recommend pieces approximately 4" x 8" for your first project. Once you have the technique down, you can try smaller pieces (leftover 2 1/2" strips work great!

***Fusible Web**

I love MistyFuse. You can also use Soft Fuse, Pellon WonderWeb, Pellon WonderWeb or any lightweight fusible web.

***Fusible Interfacing**

I recommend Pellon 906f. Choose a lightweight fusible interfacing (fusible on one side).

***Stabilizer**

I recommend Sulky's Totally Stable, Iron-on, Tear-Away Stabilizer. This will only be used if you finish your appliqué with a satin stitch.

***Clear Polyester Monofilament thread**

Used for top stitching. Alternatively you can use a fine weight (100 wt) blending thread.

Thread to coordinate with your scrap/collage fabric

Background Fabric

See pattern for yardage - basically the size of your finished quilt or project

Dritz Fray Check

Optional but helpful for securing your raw edges

Iron & a Large Pressing Surface

An old towel is perfect

Parchment Paper or Applique Pressing Sheets

Marking pen that will NOT be removed by heat

Micron pen or other pen that won't smear easily works great

Basic sewing supplies

Cutting Mat, Rotary Cutter, Fabric scissors (large and small), Sewing Machine
